



Kingston Residents' K-Pass 2026 Member Agreement

Kingston Destination Group, in cooperation with Kingston's visitor experience community, is delighted to present the Kingston Residents' K-Pass, featuring Kingston's premiere visitor attractions. Res Pass is your chance to enjoy the many experiences that make Kingston and the 1000 Islands one of Canada's top travel destinations, so that you can knowledgeably recommend them to friends and family.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Eligible Residents:** To purchase a Kingston Residents' K-Pass ("Res Pass") you must be a resident of: City of Kingston, Frontenac County, Frontenac Islands, or Loyalist Township. Verification of identity and address are required.
- Photograph and Release of Name and Likeness:** Your photograph will be taken and stored electronically. You agree that your name, photograph and video imagery may be stored and used by Kingston and the Islands Boat Line Ltd and its partners in connection with promotion of Res Pass and of tourism in Kingston.
- Included Admissions:** Subject to the restrictions in these terms and conditions, Res Pass members may present their pass to obtain a ticket or boarding pass for admission for themselves at the following attractions on a space-available basis:
 - Kingston 1000 Islands Cruises:**
 - Discovery Cruise
 - Shipwreck Cruise
 - Heart of the Islands Sightseeing Cruise
 - Kingston Trolley Tours:**
 - 24h Hop on Hop off Pass
 - Ghost & Mystery Trolley
 - Museums and other Kingston Attractions:** as listed in 2026 Residents' Pass Welcome Guide.
- Explanation of 'Space Available':** Attraction admissions are available on the basis that they are operating and open to the public and have available space to accommodate Res Pass members. Each attraction will define a space-available policy entirely at its own discretion and may change this policy at any time.
- Blackout Dates:** This agreement is accompanied by a Welcome Guide which lists "Blackout Dates" for Cruises, Trolley Tours and Pass Perks: Discounts and Offers. No tickets will be issued to Res Pass holders for Cruises and Trolley Tours departing on Blackout Dates. Pass Perks: Discounts and Offers will not be redeemable on Blackout Dates. - Cruises and Trolley Tours:** Phone and walk-up bookings will be accepted for Kingston 1000 Islands Cruises and Trolley Tours redeemed with a Res Pass. Exclusive discounts on Cruises and Trolley Tours for friends and family must be applied in person at 248 Ontario St. with Res Pass Holder present at time of booking.
- Difference from K-Pass:** The Kingston Residents' K-Pass is a distinctly different product from the 24h/48h/72h K-Pass marketed to visitors of Kingston. Offers/inclusions in K-Pass do not apply to Kingston Residents' K-Pass.
- Pass Expiry Date and Attraction Operating Season:** The Kingston Residents' K-Pass is active from May 9, 2026 until October 12, 2026. During this time, some participating attractions may be closed, and attractions may modify their schedule or programming. It is the subscriber's responsibility to contact each attraction for its operating/schedule hours.
- Photo ID:** Subscribers may be asked for Photo ID matching the name on the pass before it can be redeemed for tickets.
- Non-Transferability:** Neither the Res Pass nor tickets or boarding passes obtained using the Res Pass are transferrable. A ticket or boarding pass obtained with a Res Pass can be used only by the pass member, it cannot be given to another person. The Res Pass cannot be donated, transferred or sold to another person. If this term is violated, the privileges of the pass will be immediately revoked without refund.
- Returns and Refunds:** The Res Pass is sold as a final-sale item. Once purchased it cannot be returned or refunded.
- E-mail address:** An e-mail address will be stored by Kingston and the Islands Boatlines LTD and used to contact subscribers with timely Kingston tourism information. By purchasing this pass and accepting this agreement, you agree that we may contact you by e-mail.
- Member Guest Discounts:** Your Pass includes discounts (not free admissions) specified in the *Welcome Guide* that can be extended to visiting friends or family. Sightseeing Cruises: \$5 off, K-Pass: \$10 off, Brunch/Lunch Cruises: \$20 off, Dinner Cruises: \$30 off. Discounts apply to the publicly advertised rates and are subject to blackout dates (5), above. This offer is not combinable with any other discount, package, reduced rate or promo offer. Res Pass holder must be present at 248 Ontario St. at time of booking to redeem discounts, however, they do not have to accompany friends or family on the tour. Discounts may be revoked at any time, without notification.
